

RUBBER CONE SPRING UNIT -REAR

Remove and refit

68.30.64

Strut and joint, 1 to 5 and 7

Removing

1. Slacken the road wheel nuts, jackup and support the rear of the
vehicle - one side. Remove the
road wheel.

- Remove the hydraulic damper, see 68.15.22/23.
 Remove the radius arm, see 68.36.02.
- Pull the strut from the spring unit and knuckle joint assembly.

 Drive the knuckle joint from the
- strut.
- Release the rubber cone from its location in the sub-frame.

- Refitting
 7. Reverse the procedure in 1 to 6,
 - noting:
 a Assemble the knuckle joint,
 lubricate with Dextragrease GP
 - and locate into the radius arm. Ensure that the strut and knuckle joint are engaged as the radius arm is raised to fit the damper.
